AD Update - Sean McInnis

- NHS Juniors & Student Government are trying to increase school spirit by including elementary students in pre-activities and games and then attending NHS basketball games together. These students are asking for Boosters help with publicity.
- 305 student athletes have signed up for winter sports.
- Winter Season starts this Thursday.
- Weekly emails will begin on Monday.
- Hockey teams received their hockey jerseys and will receive their bags next week. There was an issue with the game day jerseys, but they are being taken care of.
- Creation of Double Header Nights. Cohasset will host both girls & boys basketball this winter. We will host girls & boys lacrosse this spring. We will switch locations seasonally.
