### AD Updates

- The South Shore League met and voted to start the Fall season on September 25. This will help student athletes and the school get better acclimated to the new school year and procedures.
- The Fall Volleyball season has been moved to the Fall 2 season (also known as the floating season).
- Leagues are deciding to play only within their leagues. No non-league meets/games.
- Fall sports rules will be the same for Fall 1 and Fall 2 seasons.
- We should know the levels for each sport that will be offered next week (Freshmen, JV & Varsity).
- Still looking into how spectators will work and the rules that will be in effect. Each league may have their own rules. Certainly every spectator will need to wear a mask and be 6ft apart. We will need to follow DESI guidelines as well as the town Board of Health.
- Working on Winter Sports logistics now.
- Athletics will not be the same as last year.
- The trainer will likely need a mobile office, considering the possibility of using the team room which will no longer be available for athlete use.
- Athletes may or may not be able to use the locker rooms - this issue is still pending.
- Fall athletes need to register now on Aspen, but fees will not be paid until rosters are set.
- There will be an Intramural program if we are unable to offer Freshman or JV.

- The only activity has been six families paying dues.
- Girls soccer clinic was a huge success. 130 girls registered which resulted in Boosters netting \$9500+.
