### AD Update

- Good news - all who wanted to participate in Fall sports were able to. Creation of two JV teams, blue & gold. Practices correspond with the cohort day. Every team is guaranteed a mixture of 8 home & away games.
- Spectators - we are instituting a pass program that allows two fans per household to attend. Family & close relatives have been allowed to attend the 3 Senior Celebrations. Special masks have been made for these games.
- The CCC will be closed to the public when games and high school events are in session.
- There will be limited access to fans from other towns at all SSL games.
- Passes will allow for contact tracing. These passes were partially funded by Boosters. \$500 was approved in an emergency situation by President, Kim Zayotti, so that the passes could be ordered and made in time for the games.
- Games are being streamed.
- On MWF evenings, about 90 younger kids have been coming for a workout program in conjunction with Norwell Youth Football.
- Intramural football is happening and will follow all COVID rules.
- Cheer decided not to participate in intramural cheerleading because yelling and stunting are not permitted.
- A lot of behind the scenes work has been happening. A big thank you to Robin Dole, Dave Benedict and Olivia Packler.
- We will not have any winter season information until the 1st or 2nd week of November.
- Currently, there is no league for girls hockey. We are currently asking to join other leagues.
- We are looking for a track and pool facility.

## Fundraising - Kristen & Kim

The goal is 100 cars which will hopefully raise between \$2000-2500. Attendees will need to reserve a spot online. There is a potential second movie date of October 25.
- Colleen, Kristyn, Helen, Kristen and Kim volunteered to help with movie night.
- 50/50 Raffle. Goal is to sell 200 tickets at \$100 each, raising \$20,000 to be split between the winner and Boosters. Hopeful selling dates are 10/18 thru 12/18. Additional winners will be selected throughout the sale period to win smaller prizes to help sell more tickets. These prizes will be expiring golf tournament prizes donated last year as well as sports memorabilia Kim will donate through her company. Volunteers are needed to sell tickets. If student athletes are involved in selling of the tickets questions came up as to whether MIAA will need to be contacted for approval. Cash, check and Venmo will be accepted.
- Helen is in contact with Dairy Queen to coordinate a fundraising night with Boosters receiving a % of the proceeds. More information to follow.
- Weather depending, there will be a lacrosse clinic in November and hopefully another one in April.
- It was agreed that the floating 2 season may be the best time to paint the N's on driveways.
- Senior signs will be available in March.
