



January 12, 2021 Meeting Minutes

AD Update

- Winter season is under way and we are doing the best we can with daily obstacles. Different teams/schools are going full remote which means in some cases we are adding/dropping games/meets 12-24 hours before game time.
- Students & coaches are doing great with all the readjustments.
- Enrollment is down for Winter this year, which is understandable with team reductions and MIAA restrictions.
- Swim practice has been changed to mornings only and warm pool only. All meets are home meets at Middleborro pool on Fridays. Sean was able to coordinate an invitational meet at Weston instead of states.
- There are more JV hockey games than the expected 5-8 games. 14 games have been planned.
- We are picking up games wherever we can. NHS has played more games than any other town.
- Filming as many games/meets as possible. Can be seen on Huddle.
- Fall 2 has four possible sports. Volleyball, Football, Cheer (may be moved to spring) and Track. Track will be considered indoor, but have an outdoor component. Hoping to get many sign ups for Fall 2 season.
- Volleyball will play in our own South Shore League, which has 8 teams. Games will be played in succession rather than side by side.
- Evan gave a shoutout and thanks to Sean who has done an outstanding job. The Board concurred with Evan's sentiment.

Fundraising

- Thank you to all who helped with sales & advertising the 50/50 raffle. 115 tickets were sold which raised \$11,500, split with the winner and Boosters will net \$5025. The winner is filling out tax documentation and will receive her winnings soon.
- Lacrosse Clinic - still hopeful for spring.
- Driveway N's - still on for spring.

- Senior Signs - Will be available earlier this year. Discussion on selling or giving to all and asking for donation. This year's class size is 162, compared to last year's 186. Helen thinks she can get a sponsor to cover the cost of all the signs. Last year's cost was \$820.
- Motion to deliver Senior signs to each senior like we did last year. Cara/Helen, passed unanimously.
- Golf Tournament - still on track for May 20th, no additional updates at this point.

Apparel - Kristyn

- Pop Up Sales in December were very successful. People liked to see the merchandise in person. Thank you Colleen, Cara & Janet for helping Kristyn sell.
- \$4634 sold with net \$4493. This amount puts us ahead of last year this time.
- Will be selling bags & t-shirts this spring. Looking for more ideas. Suggested ideas were golf umbrella, sand free beach towels, summer items, tie headbands & visors.

Treasurer Report- Janet

- 50/50 brought in \$11,500 with a net of \$5025
- Only one family paid dues since last meeting. An email will be going out targeting those who have not paid yet.

Scholarships - Christine

- The Scholarship application will now be on google forms to make it easier for the students to submit and the committee to read. Applications will be open soon and will be due the second week of March.
- 6 Scholarships. 3 are application based and 3 are coach nominated. Each scholarship is \$1000.
- Kim Guarachi will be taking over for Christine since she has a graduating senior.
